

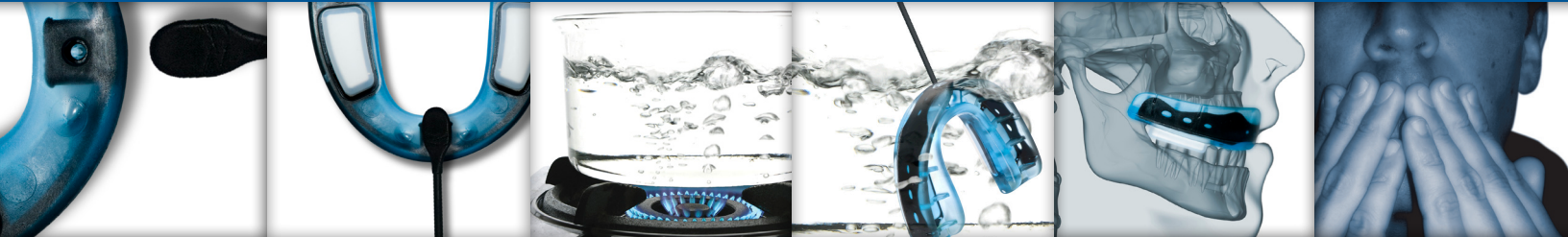


FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Boiling Accessory • Glass bowl of room temperature water • Pot of boiling water • Mirror •

• READ THROUGH ALIGN AND FORM STEPS BEFORE BEGINNING •



BOILING:

- 1 Using your thumbs, press boiling accessory into the Mouth Gear by pressing firmly.
- 2 Fill glass bowl with 6 inches of room temperature water, set aside for step 5.
- 3 Fill a pot with 6 inches of water, heat on stovetop and bring to a boil. Once water is boiling remove pot from heat source.
- 4 Submerge Mouth Gear into hot water using the Boiling Accessory Tool for **90 seconds**. Avoid allowing Mouth Gear to touch pot.
- 5 Remove the Mouth Gear from the hot water and dip it in the glass bowl of room temperature water for 1-2 seconds.
- 6 Immediately conduct steps 7-11 (Align and Form)

ALIGN & FORM: *Steps 7-10 need to occur simultaneously.

- 7 Use a mirror to align the PB logo in center of Mouth Gear with the center of your upper teeth. When Mouth Gear is inserted, lightly contact your lower teeth with the bite-pads and boiling accessory.
- 8 If the bite-pads are not touching your teeth, and are pressed against your cheeks, with your fingers, lightly push the bite-pads toward your tongue, until they make contact with lower teeth.
***If the bite-pads are touching the lower teeth, then ignore the above step.**
- 9 While forming Mouth Gear, start at your front teeth and use your fingers to firmly push the material upward, pressing firmly against your teeth and gums. Start at the front of your lips and move to the sides of your cheeks to pack the Mouth Gear tightly to form outside wall.
- 10 Continue to rest lower teeth on bite-pads, suck and swallow for approximately 60 seconds to draw out any air and water from the Mouth Gear. If your Mouth Gear fitting is not accurate repeat steps 3-10.
- 11 Remove boiling accessory by gently pulling it away from the Mouth Gear.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- Do not trim your Mouth Gear. Trimming will void your warranty and may decrease benefits.
- To maintain product integrity, do not leave your Mouth Gear in direct sunlight or in a hot car for extended periods of time.
- Clean Mouth Gear with toothbrush and toothpaste. Rinse with cool water.

- Tritan
- Silicone
- EVA (Ethyl Vinyl Acetate)

Boiling Accessory:

- Polyethylene
